In the EU, the risk assessment is based on a comparison of the predicted environmental concentration (PEC) and the predicted no-effect concentration (PNEC), the so-called PEC/PNEC ratio. In the United States, the EA is based on a comparison of the MEEC with the lowest EC50 divided by an appropriate assessment factor.

Risk characterisation usually established on the basis of risk assessment. This procedure integrates three steps of environmental assessment. One of its methods is risk rating, which is a quantitative estimation of hazard risk. However, the provided method is a simplification of the real risk characterisation.

Several factors must be considered when assessing the risk of a hazard, including populations that are most susceptible (due to intrinsic biological factors), vulnerable (due to environmental factors), and sensitive (both susceptible and vulnerable) (enHealth, 2012).
