There was no real border between British Honduras and the Yucatán in 1860 and 1861. Mahogany contractors from Belize had been encroaching on Mexican territory to cut and extract hardwoods. When the Caste War broke out in 1847, the Santa Cruz Maya, followed by the Icaiche, began to "tax" these contractors.
